

## Disinfecting Surfaces

**Important: Always follow the manufacturer's instructions!**

**We generally recommend that ready products be used (e.g. wipes).**

**If you intend to prepare the disinfectant yourself, please note the following:**

1. Fill the required quantity of cold water with the help of a large measuring cup (one litre) into a bucket.
2. Add precisely the required amount of concentrated disinfectant with the help of a small measuring cup (ml).  
Wear gloves and protective goggles while doing so!
3. Wipe the surface so that it is wet!  
Wear gloves while doing so!  
Do not wipe the surface dry.  
The surface may be used again when it has dried!  
Please always use a new cloth each time to dip into the disinfectant.



### **Please note:**

- **Do not mix disinfectants with cleaners.**
- **Make a new disinfectant solution each working day or when it becomes visibly soiled.**
- **Remove visible soiling with a cloth soaked in disinfectant before disinfecting surfaces.**
- **Wash the cloths after use at a temperature of at least 60°C and tumble-dry.**
