



## Important hygiene rules for staff at nail salons

- 1. Please do not wear arm or hand jewellery when working with clients!
- 2. We recommend that you wear working clothes (e.g. white laboratory coat).
- 3. We recommend that you disinfect your hands before and after treating clients (see sheet on disinfecting hands).
- 4. The areas of skin to be treated (hands and feet) should be washed with soap and water before the manicure or pedicure. We recommend that you disinfect the skin.
- 5. Please clean and disinfect work surfaces after each treatment (see sheet on disinfecting surfaces).
- Please disinfect all instruments employed immediately after use (tweezers, nailmachine bits) and replace disposable materials (e.g. nail files) (see sheet on disinfecting instruments).
- 7. Please only use disposable nail files or disinfected glass files (see sheet on sterilizing instruments).
- 8. Clean and disinfect the foot tub after each client (see page on disinfecting surfaces).
- 9. Please use new covers for each client (e.g. paper towels, etc.).
- 10. Thoroughly clean the floor other work surfaces, wash basins and toilets every day.
