whose parents are on a low income and have to count every penny.

That's why I'd like to tell you about the Education and Participation Package. We can help with lots of things - such as membership of a sports club, lunch at school or a guided museum visit. This leaflet gives you an overview of options for support.

Staff at Jobcenter Frankfurt and the community halls (Sozialrathäuser) will be happy to advise on the requirements for full or partial payment of membership fees, music lessons and other costs. I would be very happy if you would actively take advantage of these opportunities.

Who is the Education and Participation Package aimed at?

Children and young people are entitled to education and participation benefits if their parents receive one of the following benefits:

- Family allowance
- Housing benefit
- Unemployment assistance (Arbeitslosengeld II)
- Basic subsistence income for the elderly and for persons with reduced earning capacity
- Subsistence allowance
- Asylum Seekers' Benefit Act

or whose parents have a low income, but have so far not received any of the above benefits.

Young adults up to the age of 25 years who are in education and do not have their own income are also entitled to these benefits.

How do you receive support?

You do not need to fill in an official form to benefit from the opportunities of the Education and Participation Package, you can just send us an email.

From **01/08/2019** you will need to make a separate application for learning support. You will automatically receive all other education and participation benefits upon presentation of proof.

What benefits are included in the Education and Participation Package?

- A lump sum (cash benefit in two instalments) per school year for **school supplies** such as stationery, bags and similar.
- 15 Euro per month for **participation** and support for sport, cultural and other leisure activities.
(for example, course fees for music lessons or sports club membership)
- Payment of costs for group **lunch** at school or day nursery
- Payment of costs for **day trips** from school or day nursery
- Payment of costs for **school trips** lasting several days or day nursery trips lasting several days
- Payment of costs for **learning support**
- Payment of costs for **pupil transport**, if the nearest school can only be reached by bus or train, the journey to school is more than 3 kilometres and the ticket is not paid by other authorities such as the city education authority.
